State of play

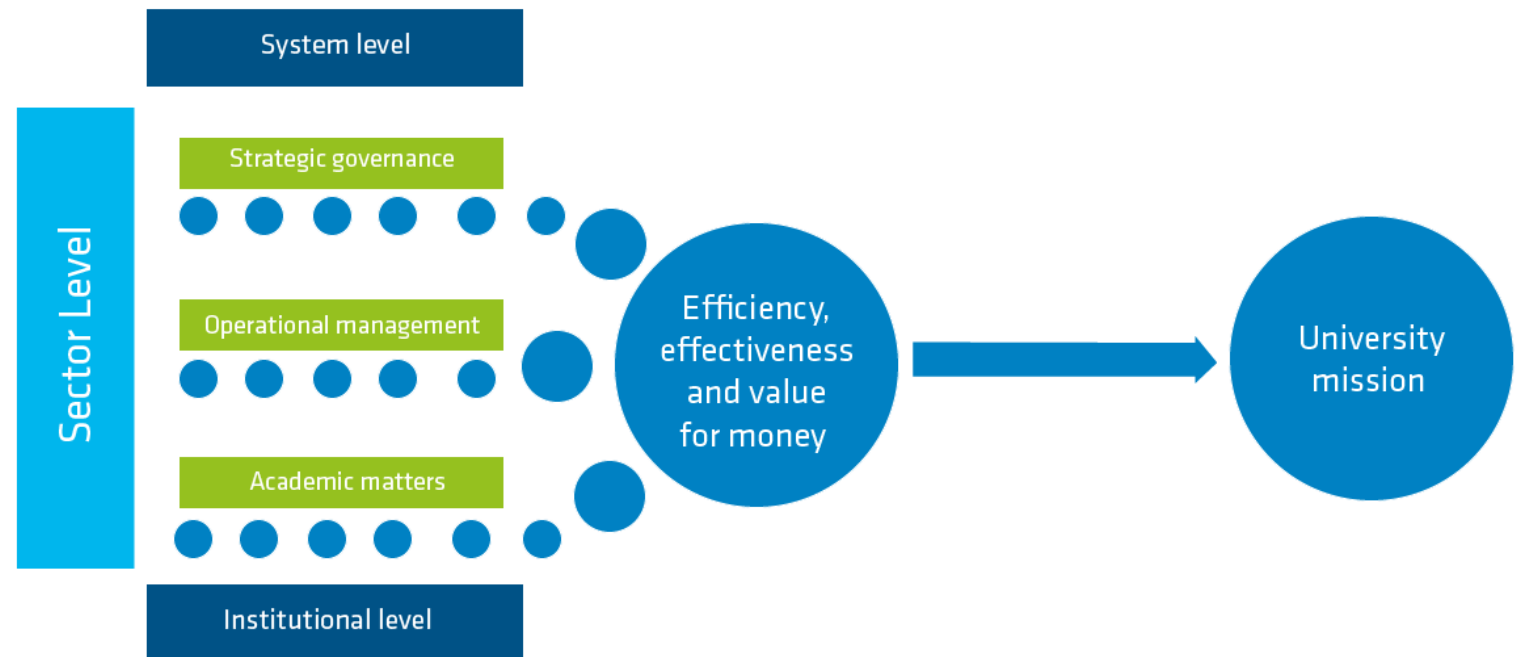
- Growing attention to efficiency in a changing context (funding, accountability, student numbers...)

- Varied interest and concerns about quality and long-term impact



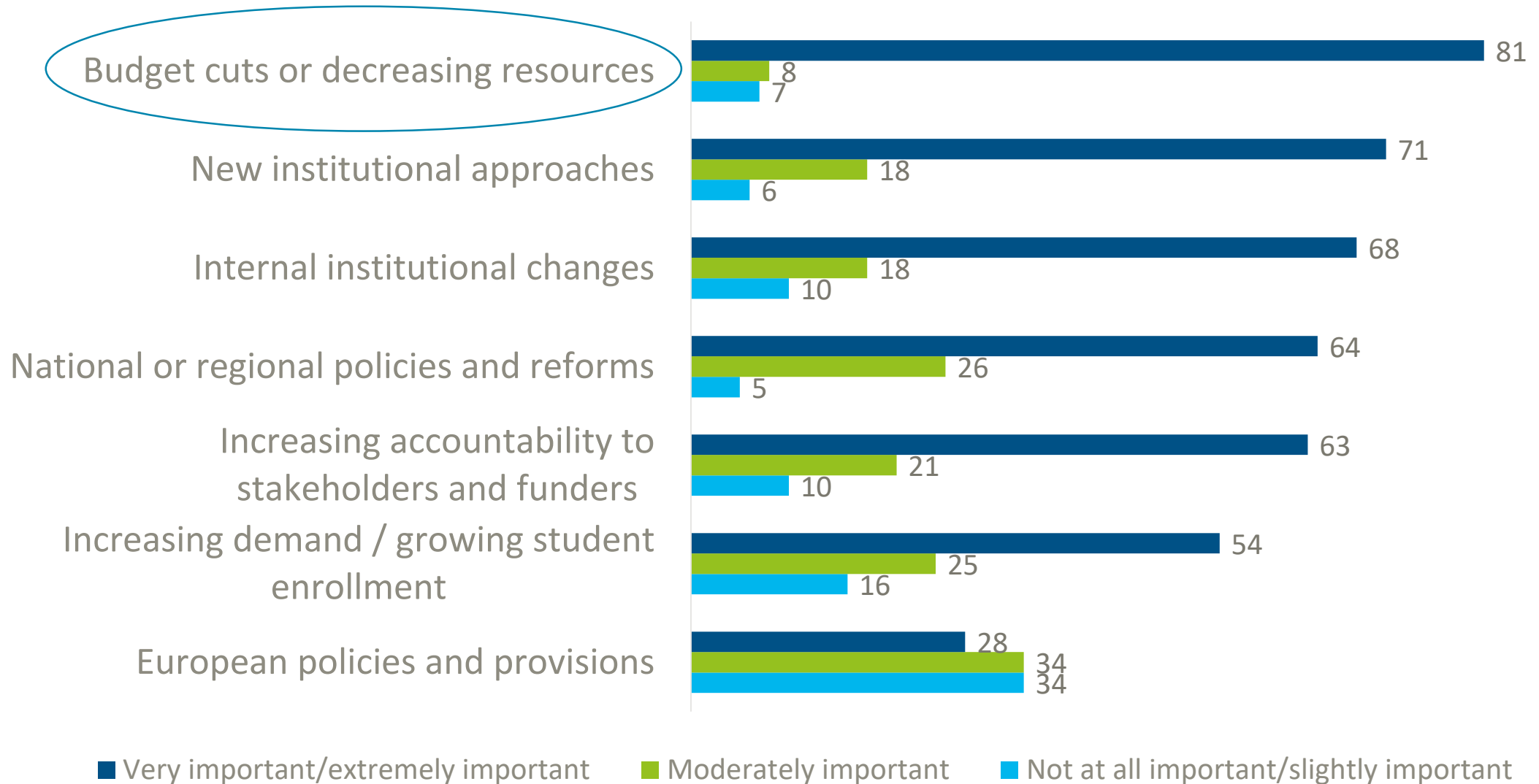
USTREAM approach

- All university settings (strategic management, operations and academic matters)

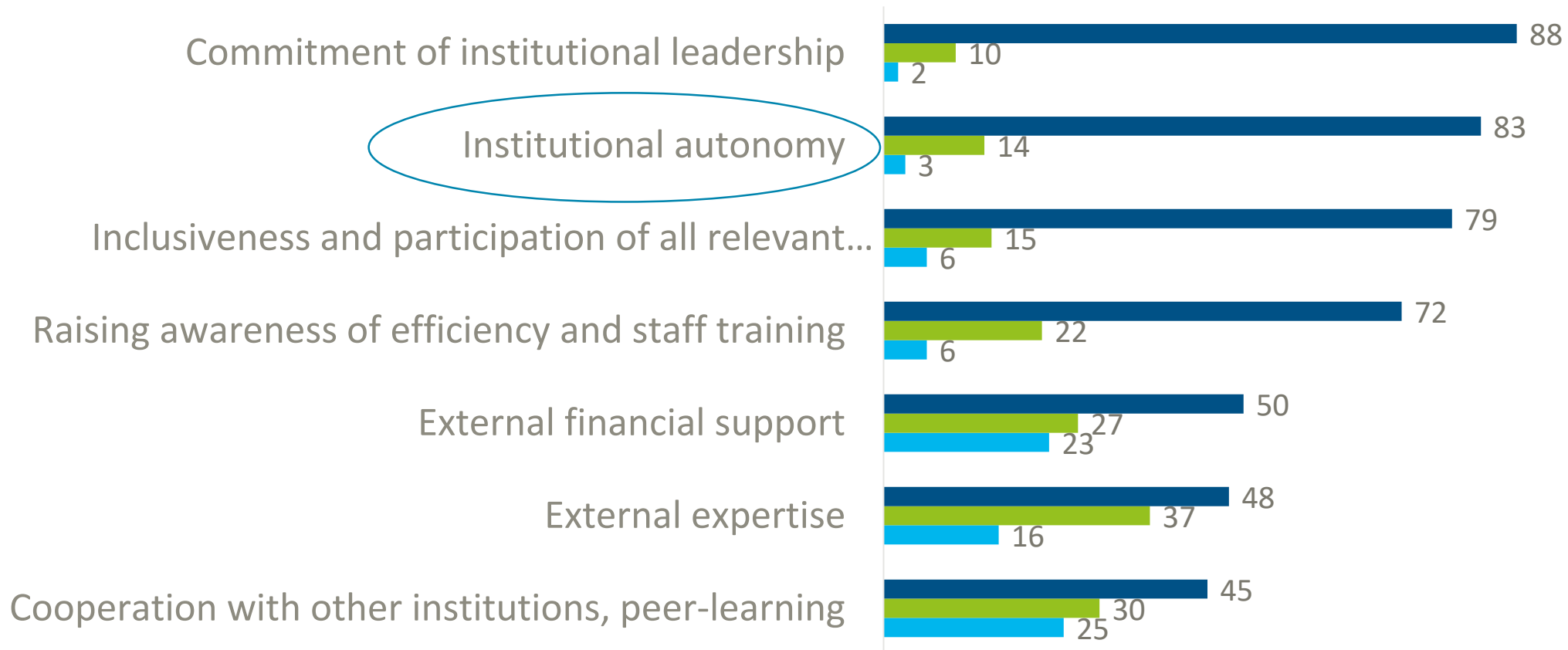


Key drivers of efficiency



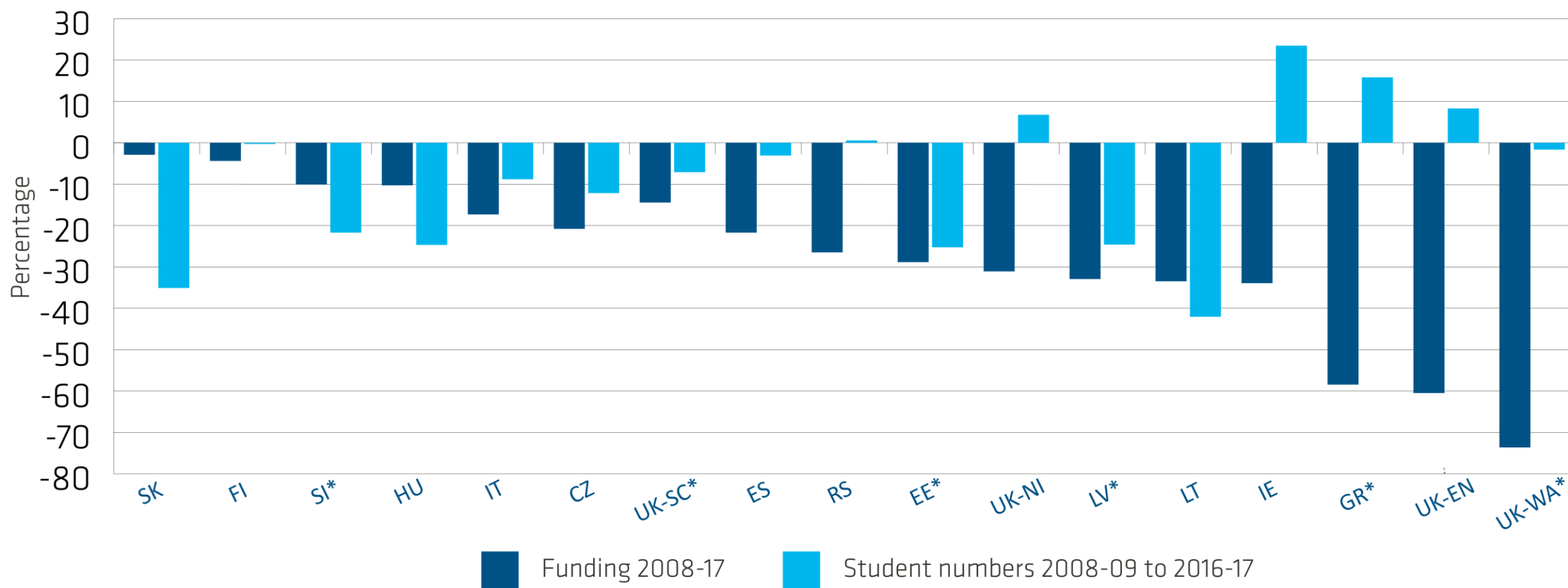

Key enablers of efficiency



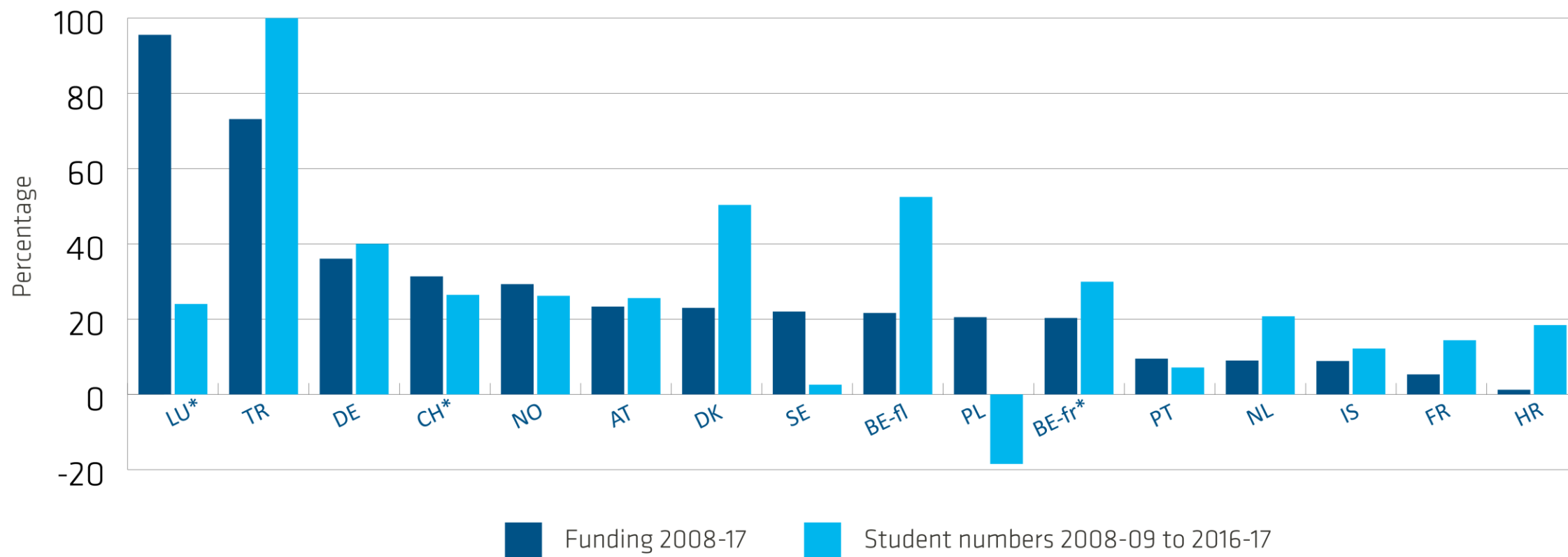

Systems with growing public funding for universities 2008-2017





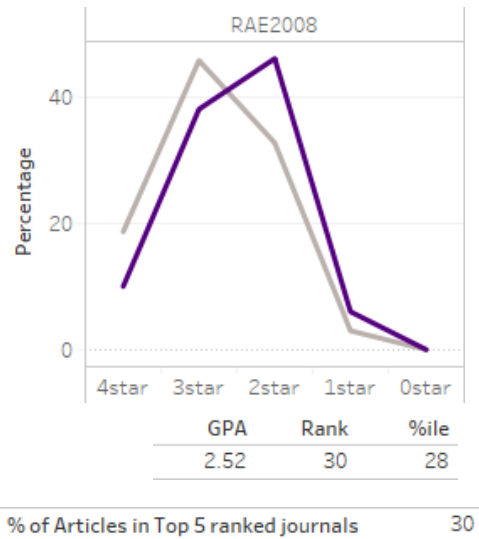

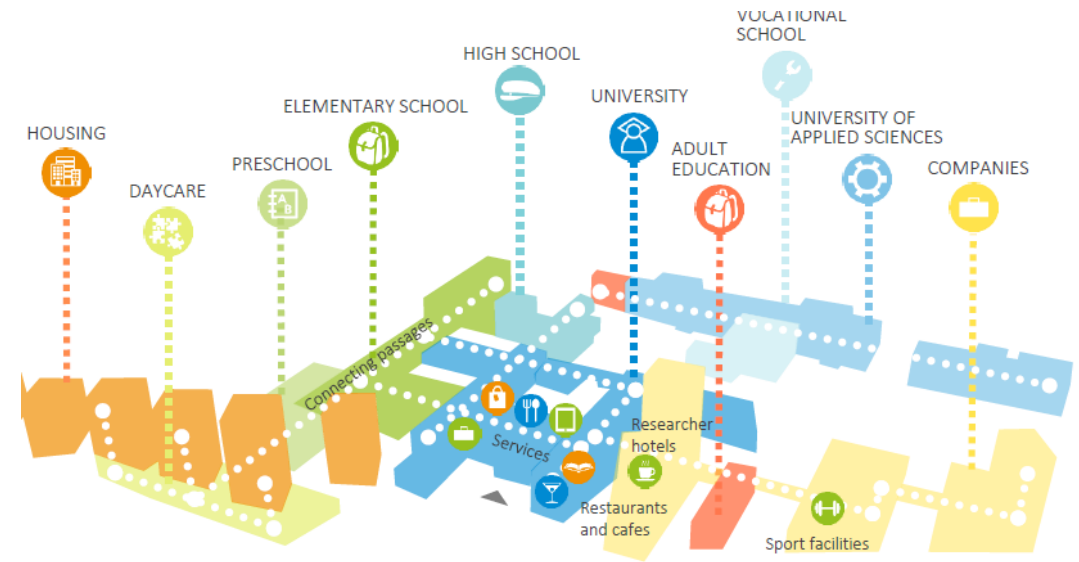

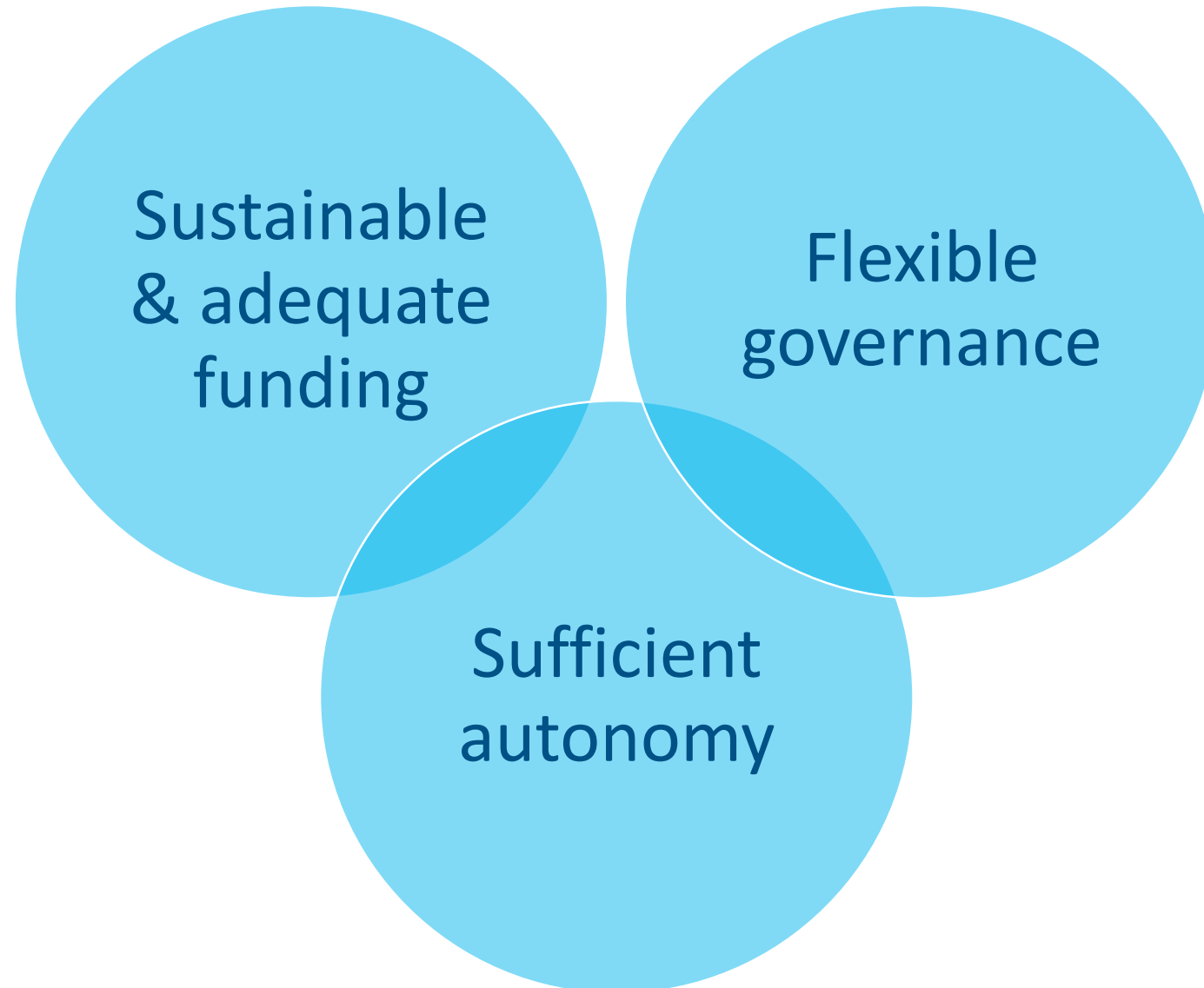

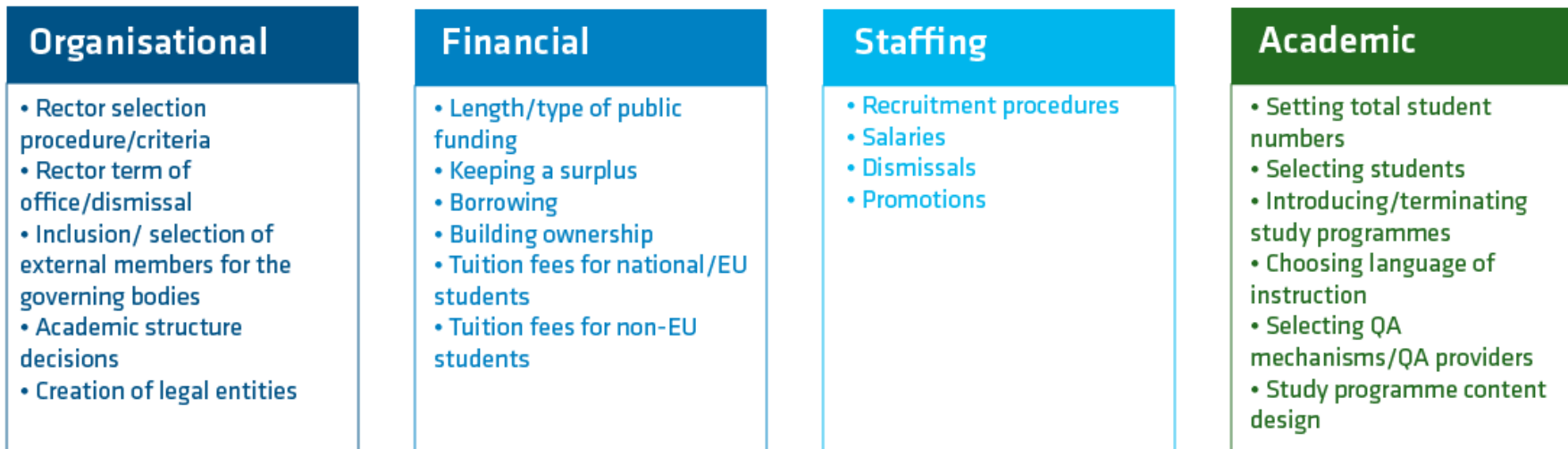
Why Sustainable & adequate funding?



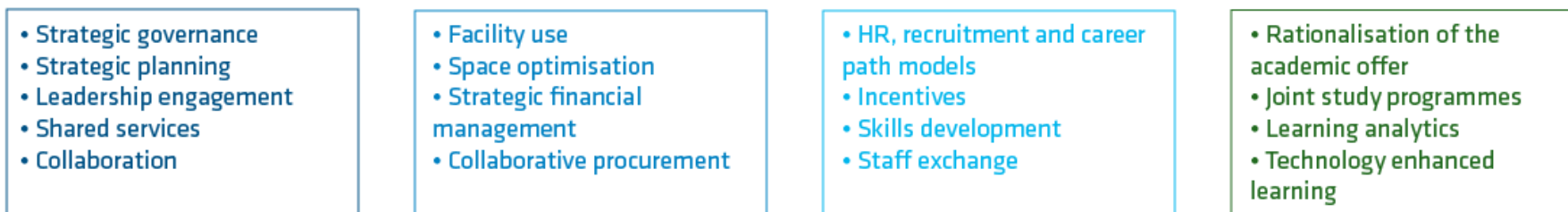
- Chronicle underfunding prevents HEIs to implement efficiency (e.g. invest in enabling technology and skills)

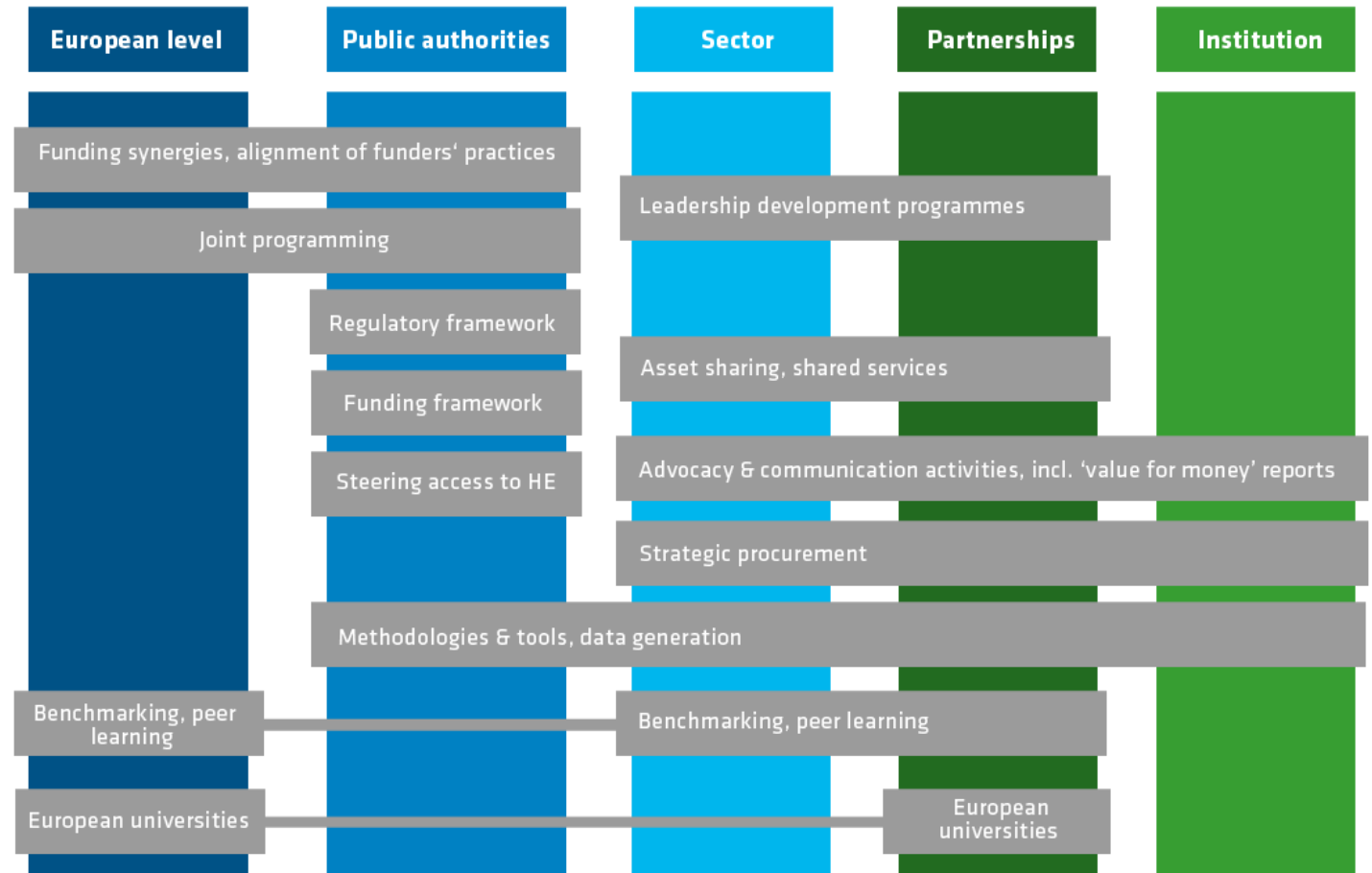

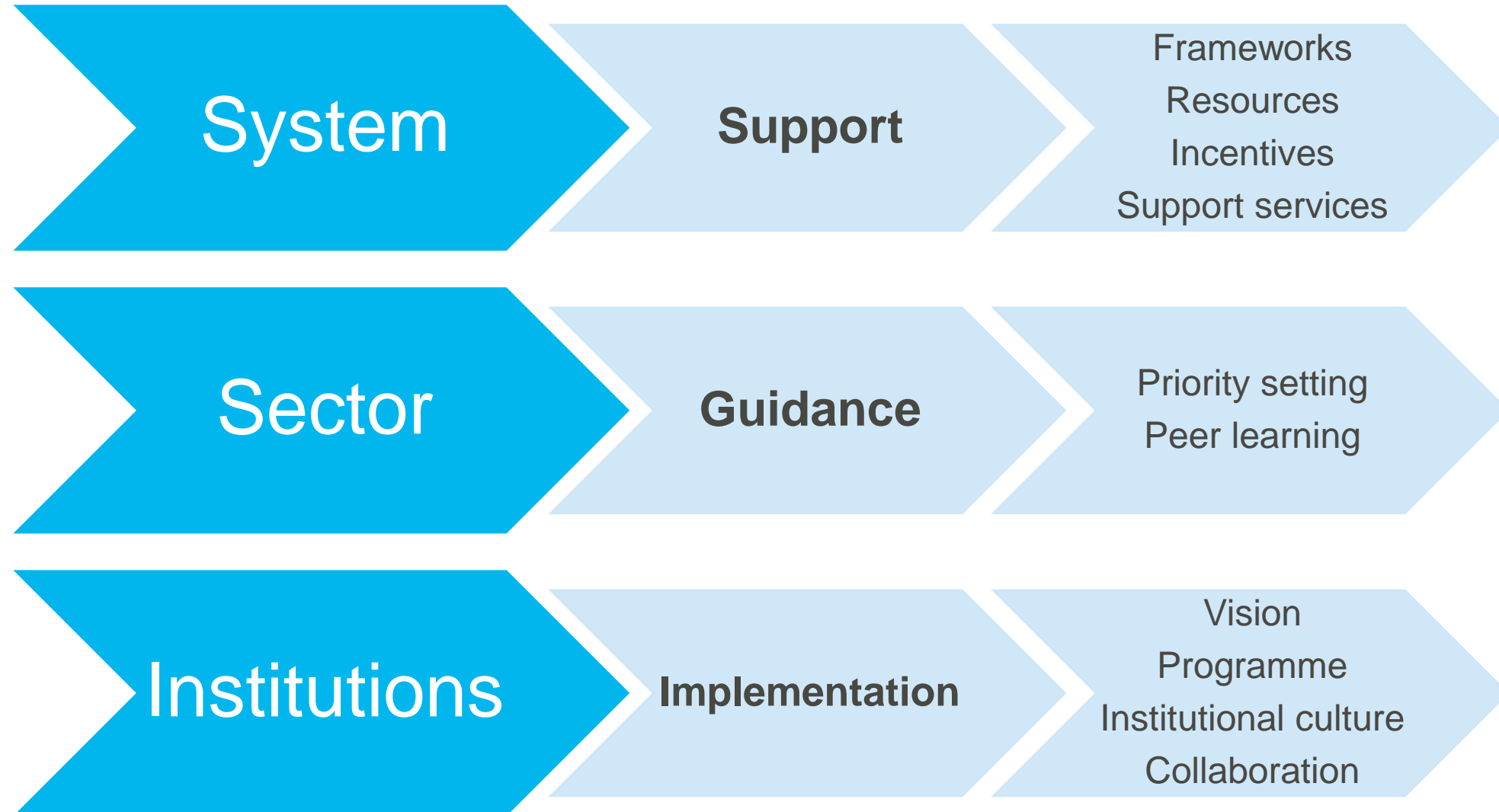

- Efficiency is a collective responsibility of all HE stakeholders

Considerations for policy makers

- Provide sustainable and adequate core funding
- Base expectations on realistic outcomes
- Link efficiency to achievement of the university's goals and missions
- Reward universities for efficiency gains through incentives
- Maintain a strategic dialogue and promote peer learning
- Foster partnerships and sector-level collaboration
- Establish bodies or services that help enhance efficiency
